### **May 2**

Officers responded to a vicious biting dogs complaint in the area of 15 Mile and Ryan. The officers were forced to defend themselves resulting in the vicious dog being shot. The animal did not survive. The Pit Bull was quarantined in police custody for the safety of the community.
