Dog Bites 2-Year-Old Boy

Boy Listed In Stable Condition

LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, Ohio -- A 2-year-old boy was hospitalized after being bitten by a family dog Tuesday afternoon, **News 5's** Juliette Vara reported.



Police said the boy was bitten on the face and the back of the head by his grandparent's Akita in the 5800 block of Princeton-Glendale Road.

The boy was identified as Ethan Kreiner.

Officials said Kreiner was playing with the dog inside the home when it attacked him for an unknown reason. They said he had a bite mark on his cheek and the back of his head, Vara reported.

According to neighbors, the dog had been a friendly pet with the family for about six years.

"I've never had any trouble with him," said Tim Eastham, a neighbor. "He was a pretty friendly dog to me. He's never really barked at me."

He was taken to Children's Hospital, and is listed in fair condition.

The dog warden removed the dog from the home.
