Police on lookout for dog after Laurel attack

A Laurel woman needed 70 stitches in her head after a possible stray German Shepherd attacked her Friday morning.

County police said the incident happened about 7:18 a.m. in the 3200 block of Hayshire Street. Police this morning said Janice Harrah, 55, is still at Laurel Regional Hospital and is undergoing rabies shots.

Police said they don't know if the dog is a stray or may have rabies, but they've increased patrols in the area since the attack.

Police are asking local community associations for their assistance in informing others about the attack.
