Rare Breed of Dog Attacks Maui Woman



Another dog attack on Maui has the Maui Humane Society on alert.

It was just last month a Pit Bull named "Faust" was euthanized after it attacked several people.

This most recent case involves a rare asian breed named Jindo.

The brother of the Caroline Sarmiento told KHNL News 8 about the vicious attack by the Jindo dog only found in Korea, saying his sister suffered multiple bites on her body.

This attack happened back in March, but it wasn't until this week Humane Society officials deemed the dog dangerous to the point it had to be kept behind closed doors.

The dog lives four doors down from Sarmiento, and pounced just as she was headed out the door.

The bite to Sarmiento's arm was so serious she was sent to the hospital.

For now the Maui Humane society has declared the Jindo dangerous, and it must be muzzled and on a leash no of no more than three feet in length.

In Korea, these dogs are prized possessions, and are considered national treasures.

Exporting them from the country is extremely difficult, and only done with special government permission.

The dog now faces possible execution.
