A TWO-year-old Brisbane girl has been attacked by her grandmother's dog on a property in Victoria.

The girl was playing with a border collie last night when it bit her on the head leaving a 15cm-long gash.

The toddler's mother told Channel Nine news that she witnessed the mauling and immediately put pressure on her daughter's head with a towel to stem the bleeding.

The girl was airlifted to a Melbourne hospital for surgery where she is in a stable condition.

The dog, which was a family pet of two years has been destroyed.
