Fitchburg 3-year-old is treated for dog bite

FITCHBURG— A family dog bit a 3-year-old boy several times yesterday, after which the child was brought by ambulance to UMass Memorial — HealthAlliance Leominster Campus.

Police did not release information about the type of dog involved in the attack, which occurred about 2:40 p.m. at 65 Frederick St.

However, a man who lives at the residence was seen walking a chocolate Labrador shortly after the incident. He declined to comment on the attack.

Scanner reports indicated the dog was not registered by the city.

Police said the bites were not life-threatening.

The city's animal officer is investigating the incident. No citations had been issued as of last night.
