Infant being treated after dog attack

ARLINGTON — An infant is being treated today for injuries after being attacked by a dog, officials said.

Emergency medical crews said the boy suffered 2- to 4-inch lacerations, including injuries to his upper forehead. Officers were in the south Arlington neighborhood at about 2 p.m. today when someone reported that the child had been attacked by a dog at a house in the 5400 block of Creekridge Drive.

The child was taken by helicopter ambulance to Cook Children's Medical Center in Fort Worth.

Officials described the dog as a 120-pound mixed Chow and Husky.
