## Child hospitalized for dog bite

FOUR OAKS - A child was taken to Johnston Memorial Hospital on Saturday after sustaining "a pretty bad dog bite," said Ernie Wilkinson, director of Johnston County Animal Services.

No other details were immediately available about the age or condition of the child, who was attacked by a pet English bulldog, Wilkinson said. Wilkinson said the child was airlifted to a trauma hospital in the Triangle.

The dog, which was current on its rabies vaccination, is in quarantine, he said.
