Dog attacks toddler at local beach

A 2-year-old Norfolk boy is recovering from a vicious dog attack. Cayden Roberts was swimming at an Ocean View beach when a stranger's dog bit him in the face.

Monday night's attack began a 12-hour stay in the hospital and when the family tried to call the dog's owner they got an unexpected surprise - the name and number he gave the family was bogus.

He also claimed the dog had it's rabies shots, but they weren't going to take **his** word for it and now Cayden has to endure 22 painful anti-rabies shots just to be safe. He's had six shots in his face and two in each leg. He has to return in three, seven, 14 and 28 days to complete the series of shots.

Quincy Roberts, Cayden's mom, is in between jobs and has no health insurance to cover medical costs, which have run upwards of about \$4-5,000.

Cayden is doing O.K. now and luckily isn't afraid of dogs - he has two of his own.
