West side dog bite

Dog bite: The Department of Public Health is looking for information regarding a dog that bit a woman about 9:30 a.m. Saturday on Glenway Street between Regent and Hillcrest.

The woman jogger was bitten by a small, cream-colored "Shih Tzu-type" dog that was being walked on a leash by an elderly white male, according to a release from the Dane County Department of Public Health. The release says if the animal is not located, the victim may be required to complete a series of painful and costly injections to prevent rabies.

Anyone with information regarding the incident is asked to call the police and fire dispatcher at 255-2345 and ask for the animal services officer.
