A little girl is attacked after getting too close to a dog.

She was mauled Saturday night near I-35 and Quintana Road in Von Ormy. The attack happened about a block away from a restaurant. Her parents rushed her there to find help. Luckily, there were two deputies inside having dinner. They radioed for help after they saw the little girl was covered in blood.

Animal Care Services caught two dogs. One is believed to be the animal that attacked the child. News 4 learned the dogs belong to the little girl's uncle. Investigators say the attack was unprovoked. The uncle was ticketed for not having current shots or tags for the dogs.

Animal Care Services also took a litter of puppies. It is unclear what will happen to the animals.

The little girl is in serious condition, but is expected to survive.
