Zionsville dog attacks UPS driver in truck

A Zionsville woman was cited for allowing a dog bite after one of two boxers she owns attacked a UPS driver in his truck Wednesday.

Boone County Sheriff's Deputy Chris Burcham said driver Michael Strack was trying to make a delivery at the residence behind the home of Deborah Wingerter when the Boxer leaped past its invisible fence and lunged at Strack.

Strack was bitten on the left calf and treated by Witham Memorial Hospital medics.

Wingerter, who lives in the 9900 block of E. 200 S., identified the dog who bit Strack as Apollo.

Sheriff's spokesman Deputy A.J. Naekel said Apollo was up to date on his shots but was quarantined by the Zionsville Country Vet clinic as a temporary safeguard.
