## Aggressive dog bites the hand that feeds it

A look at unusual items from area police departments:

CLAYTON — Nov. 19: Officers responded to the 7000 block of Westbrook Road on a dog bite.

The reporting officer observed a medic crew on scene, and they warned about an aggressive dog on the loose.

The officer saw a large German shepherd running toward him. He tried to climb onto the hood of a vehicle but couldn't get his footing. He removed his gun from its holster to defend himself, but the dog turned and ran wildly around the driveway and front yard.

A female at the door of the residence got the dog inside and locked it in a room.

The female, who suffered a serious bite wound that included puncture marks in her palm, said she owned the dog and didn't know why it bit her. She was taken to a hospital and issued an animal bite quarantine order.
