### Dog attacks its owners living in van at MCC

A dog was taken away by Mesa Animal Control officers Tuesday after it attacked its owners, who were living in a van at Mesa Community College, police said. The Manchester Terrier first attacked a 14-year-old boy, then his mother, who tried to intervene, police said. Both the mom and son suffered non life-threatening injuries.

The incident occurred just after 10 a.m. and was brought to police attention by a passerby.

Standard Manchester Terriers are generally between 12 and 22 pounds, with the toy varieties being smaller, according to the American Kennel Club.
