Police Shoot Dog After Attack

KANSAS CITY, Mo. -- When police arrived in the 2400 block of Quincey on Monday night they encountered an out-of-control angry dog that had just bitten its owner, they said.

The owner asked police to put it down and police obliged.

"When it was a puppy, it was nice. But now it's mean," said 8-year-old Dasha Williams, whose grandmother was bitten by the dog.

With the permission of her grandfather, Dasha told KCTV5's [Craig Nigrelli](#) what happened at the home where her grandparents are raising her. She said the family dog, Brownie, bit through its chain in the backyard and attacked when her grandmother tried to corral it.

Dasha said the dog bit her grandmother on the arm.

When animal control, police and an ambulance arrived, the dog was still on the loose in back of the house.

"I talked with the owner of the dog. She's the victim of the dog bite. She said, 'Hey, it's a problem dog.' She wanted him destroyed," said Sgt. Cory Lemoine of the Kansas City Police Department.

Dasha said police shot the German shepherd twice.

The injured grandmother was taken to the hospital with a bandaged arm.

KCTV5's [Nigrelli](#) asked Dasha, "Are you sad or glad that it's gone?"

"A little happy, because he tried to bite me once," Dasha said.
