Woman recovering from dog attack Herald-Leader Staff Report

A Pulaski County woman is recovering from what police described as a "vicious" dog attack.

Dorothy F Chevalier, 58, was outside her home just east of Somerset on Monday afternoon when two boxers that belong to neighbors attacked her, according to a news release from the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office.

Chevalier suffered severe cuts on her arms and legs and was flown to the University of Kentucky Medical Center. Her condition was upgraded to fair on Tuesday, said Pulaski County Sheriff Todd Wood.

The release from Wood's office said police hadn't been able to talk to Chevalier and that as a result the circumstances of the attack weren't clear.

The dog most involved in the attack, a male boxer, had been let out of the house to go to the bathroom just before the attack, and a female boxer joined in. A third dog was present during the attack but did not take part, the sheriff's office said.

Wood said all three dogs will be quarantined for 10 days to make sure they don't have diseases. The county attorney's office will review the case and decide if any charges are warranted.
