## Man Recovering After Bulldog Attack



**September 4, 2007**--A Des Moines man is still in the hospital, after being attacked by a dog on the city's east side Monday. "He had Dozer like this. Dozer was hanging on his arm and just hanging. He was like Dozer, get off. Just get off. Let go. That's all he kept saying," says Sarah Reinier.

Reinier and her uncle were bitten by an American Bulldog named Dozer. Sarah needed nine stitches, and her uncle needed surgery for a broken arm. It happened during the Labor Day parade on the city's east side.



Police say an argument broke out between two men, causing the dog to go on the attack. A three-year-old girl suffered minor injuries. Dozer spent the night in the custody of Animal Control. The animal's future will be decided following an evaluation later today.
