## Dog-bite claim unleashed

A Calgary postal worker who was allegedly attacked by a dog last month has testified the dog was off its leash at the time.

Goran Sofic, 39, told a dangerous dog hearing yesterday he was delivering mail in a trailer park in the 6200 block of 17 Ave. S.E. and didn't see the white husky until seconds before it attacked him.

Sofic suffered four cuts to his hand and required a total of eight stitches.

He testified the dog appeared to be wearing a broken leash at the time.

Sofic said the dog had tried to jump him once before but was restrained by a leash.

The animal was seized by city bylaw officials.

The hearing is being held to determine if the dog should be euthanized as a danger to the public.
