Dog Owners Step Forward In Dog Bite Case

The owners of a dog that brought this year's pooch paddle at Sioux City's Riverside pool to an abrupt end, have stepped forward.

The dog in question attacked another dog at the event before turning on someone trying to break up the fight.

At the time, no one claimed the animal and it was held by Sioux City Animal Control.

Cindy Rarrat from Animal Control says the owners of the dog have come forward and expressed interest in taking it home.

Cindy Rarrat, Sioux City Humane Society says, "They did come forward. They are very responsible people. They want to do the right thing by the dog and by the victims in this case so they are working on it to come to a resolution to make sure that everybody is happy."

Rarrat says the dog's owners will be cited for their dog running loose.

She also said a lot of the trouble with this incident could have been avoided if the dog had proper identification, a rabies and city license on its collar.
