Monday's Blotter: Woman allegedly assaulted by friend's neighbor

A caller told police around 1 a.m. Monday that while she was at party at a friend's house in the 8200 block of Delfino Circle, a neighbor came over.

For an unknown reason, she asked the neighbor to leave and "he grabbed her by the hair, dragged her down the walkway" and then "punched her numerous times."

The man called about an hour and a half later and said he wanted to "tell his side of the story."

Dumbreck Drive, 9500 block, medical emergency. A quadriplegic man could not breathe, 4:04 a.m.

Dairyview Circle, 17400 block, residential burglary. Someone broke into a resident's house while he was sleeping and stole a camcorder, 4:58 a.m.

Pacific Coast Highway, 21500 block, welfare check. A caller said that an 11-year-old boy was sitting on a bench in front of the Hyatt resort and was worried about his well-being. Police discovered that the boy was actually a 20-year-old man who was waiting for a bus, 5:32 a.m.

Clancy Lane, 19600 block, vehicle burglary. A Microsoft Zune mp3 player, a PlayStation and a backpack were stolen from a 2007 Ford Ranger while it was parked in a resident's driveway, 7:09 a.m.
