Plymouth girl attacked by dog in Marshfield

MARSHFIELD — A 5-year-old girl is being treated for serious bite wounds after her grandfather's dog attacked her in his Marshfield home.

The girl was bitten on the head and face near her left eye, fire officials said.

She was taken by helicopter to Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. Firefighters were called to a house on Old Mount Skirgo Road at 4:14 p.m. Tuesday, Marshfield Fire Lt. Thomas Corbo said.

The girl and her 8-year-old sister, who live in Plymouth, were with their grandfather at his house when the attack happened. Corbo described the dog as a mixed breed. No further details were released this morning.
