



## Goat-Attacking Dogs Captured In Hollister

Dogs Seen Attacking Animals On Union Heights Drive

HOLLISTER, Calif. - Some German shepherds roaming Hollister that were allegedly attacking goats and other animals in the area have been captured, animal control officials said Wednesday.

Officials first received reports about dogs attacking animals Dec. 16 from residents living on Union Heights Drive.

When control officers arrived at the scene, they looked for the stray dogs, which were reportedly well-groomed German shepherds, officials said.

On Dec. 18, there was another report about the dogs. Officers responded to the area but were unable to find the dogs.

Animal Control then were contacted Monday, and were told that the dogs had returned to the Union Heights Drive area, officials said.

When officers responded to the area, they found two German shepherds attacking goats.

Officers were able to capture one of the dogs and followed the second dog to Riverside Road. One of the dogs had blood on its fur, officials said.

At Riverside Road, two more German shepherd dogs were captured near a house.

The owner of the dogs was cited and the incident has been referred to the district attorney's office.

A fourth German shepherd was captured Tuesday after it tried to attack another goat on Union Heights Drive, officials said.

Animal control officers said they encountered other stray dogs the area of Union Heights Drive and have warned their owners to contain the animals.
