Stray Dog Attacks Toddler

SAN ANTONIO -- A toddler is recovering Wednesday evening after a dog attack on the 1100 block of East Crockett.

Mark Carrasco, 2, was outside when a stray dog attacked the child, his parents said.

"I bought him McDonald's before I dropped him off, so I'm thinking the dog attacked for that," Lisa Carrasco said. "But my son likes to fight for his food, so I guess that's what he tried to do and the dog got him."

Carrasco, the child's mother, had just dropped the child off with his father, Rafael Cisneros.

"When I got his juice, we heard a yell," he said. "When he yelled, we ran and there was a dog on top of him."

The child was taken to University Hospital for surgery. His parents tell KSAT 12 News that Mark is out of surgery and OK.
