Woman Needs 60 Stitches To Her Face After Dog Attack In Moon

Woman And Her Son Were Walking To Store When Two Dogs Attacked

MOON, Pa. -- Jessica Cooper said she ordered her 7-year-old son to duck and cover his head when the two dogs attacked along Oakwood Drive in Moon Township Monday.

She then covered his body with her own and called 911 from her cell phone as the dogs attacked.

Police arrived and found Cooper lying on top of her son in the middle of the street.

As police tried to assist, one of the dogs began growling and approaching them.

Police Tased the dog and it ran into some nearby woods.

Cooper received 60 stitches to her face as a result of the attack and will need additional plastic surgery.

The owner of the dogs has been cited for two counts of not having their dogs properly licensed and other charges.
