

Infant attacked, killed by dog

An infant was killed Monday morning in south Tulsa after he was attacked by a dog, police said.

Officer Jason Willingham said a two-month-old baby boy was mauled by either a young black Labrador or a small pug at the boy's home in the 2900 block of East 102nd Street.

Officers were notified about 10:30 a.m. The child was pronounced dead at the scene.

Willingham said the baby's mother and grandmother were home at the time, but nobody was in the room when the attack occurred.

"The child was left unattended in a swing," he said.

Police are unsure what caused the dogs to attack or which dog killed the boy. Both dogs were placed in a shelter.

Willingham said he is not sure what, if any, charges would result from the case.

"It's just a very tragic set of circumstances," he said. "It's a very hard situation to investigate."
