Dogs taken into custody after attack

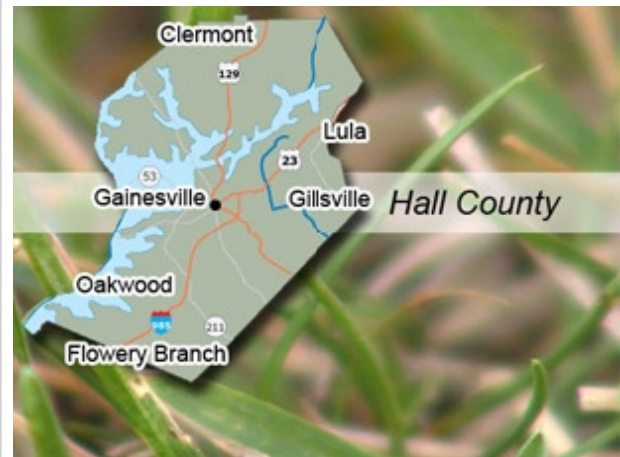
GAINESVILLE - Two dogs previously accused of threatening sheriff's deputies have been picked up by Hall County Animal Control after attacking a man as he mowed the lawn Friday afternoon.

Hall County Sheriff's Maj. Jeff Strickland said authorities determined the dogs belonged to Frank Lee Reeves of Baker Road in Gainesville.

"He was issued two citations by Animal Control for allowing his animals to run loose and for his animals having no tags," Strickland said.

He said the man who was being attacked fought the dogs off with a stick after they attacked him in the 3500 block of Baker Road.

Reeves had another dog that was fatally shot on June 23. Officials said the dogs were fired by deputies at after they charged the officers as they entered Reeves' residence with an arrested warrant for his nephew.
