

Dog bites postman, officer

A Fergus Falls man will receive a citation for a dangerous dog after his cocker spaniel bit first a postal carrier then a police officer.

According to Fergus Falls police, a postal carrier was delivering mail along the 1100 block of Mabelle Avenue around 11:30 a.m. Monday when a cocker spaniel belonging to Kristian Stanley Kristiansen ran across Kristiansen's yard and bit the postal carrier on the calf as he stood near his vehicle.

The postal carrier later told police the dog is usually chained and he was waiting for the chain to catch.

After postmaster Brad Beck reported the incident to Fergus Falls police, an officer visiting Kristiansen's residence was bitten by the same dog on the inside of his knee cap.

The officer took the cocker spaniel to the Humane Society and Kristiansen will receive a citation for a dangerous dog.

The dog is up-to-date on its vaccinations.
