

Girl treated for dog bite wounds

An 11-year-old girl suffered puncture wounds when bitten by a neighbor's German shepherd/greyhound dog Tuesday, a sheriff's sergeant reported.

Savannah Fielder of Dilton-Mankin Road was treated by paramedics and at Middle Tennessee Medical Center, Sgt. Derek Oeser reported.

The dog attacked Savannah in her back yard, the sergeant reported.

"I observed four significant puncture wounds to the right arm of the victim who was treated by EMS (Emergency Medical Services) personnel and later transported for evaluation," Oeser reported.

Oeser contacted owner Christa Barakat about the girl's injuries.

"Ms. Barakat stated the dog did have a history of attacks," Oeser reported.

The sheriff's office notified Animal Control to investigate.
