

## Woman stable after attack by dog pack

WHITE PINE - A Jefferson County woman remained in stable condition Saturday night, two days after being bitten by a pack of dogs while jogging.

Jessica Zajac, 22, was running along Bacon Road when seven or eight blue heelers attacked her around 6 p.m. Thursday, according to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office.

A helicopter carried her to the University of Tennessee Medical Center, where she remained Saturday night.

Animal control officers seized four of the dogs and cited their owner, Rodney Humphrey, 37, on a charge of letting the dogs run at large.
