

Dog bites 2 boys in the face

A dog bit a woman and two children after it got out of its backyard through an open gate around 5 p.m. Tuesday, according to Gilbert police.

The dog bit the 11-year-old and 13-year-old boys as they were apparently trying to help catch the yellow Chow that had escaped on the 100 block of South Catalina Street.

Both boys were bit in the face and had lacerations to their face and lips, police said

A 46-year-old woman got bit on her upper left arm and wrist while trying to get the dog off of the boys, according to police.

The woman may have also suffered a broken wrist as a result of the bite, according to police.

The woman and the two boys were transported to hospitals.

Officers were able to contain the dog and give it to its owner until Rabies and Animal Control arrived to take custody of the animal, police said.
