## **Man bit by dog; shepherd mix sought for quarantine**

WENATCHEE — Authorities are looking for a shepherd-mix dog that bit a man Friday in the 1100 block of Wenatchee Avenue.

Wenatchee Valley Humane Society Sgt. Jody White said the dog has long black hair with a few white tufts. It was wearing a harness.

She said the bite victim, who did not want to be identified, was taken to the hospital with multiple puncture wounds on his hand. White said it is standard procedure to quarantine an animal after it bites someone to make sure it doesn't have any diseases such as rabies.
