## Fort Lupton boy injured in severe dog attack

A 7-year-old Fort Lupton boy was taken to Children's Hospital in Aurora by Med Evac on Saturday night suffering sever injuries from a dog attack.

The boy was playing in the back yard of his neighbor, Mario Garcia-Guaderrama, 38, in the 900 block of Stage Drive The dog attacked the boy and inflicted severe injuries, including a puncture wound to his left temple that exposed the skull and his lower lip was bitten completely in half.

"It's the worst dog bite I've ever seen," said Fort Lupton police Sgt. Kevin Halloran. He said the boy was stable when he was transported. The incident happened at about 5:50 p.m., he said.

He said the boy commonly plays in the neighbor's yard.

The dog owner, Garcia-Guaderrama was given a summons for an animal causing danger, which will require a court appearance in municipal court, Halloran said.
