



Dog in Chatsworth attack is euthanized

A large dog that attacked three people in Chatsworth last month has been euthanized while authorities investigate whether a second dog was involved in the altercation, Animal Services officials said Friday.

The two boxers escaped from their fenced yard in the 19900 block of Hiawatha Street on March 19, and terrorized several people, officials said.

A boxer named Tony, believed to have bitten three people, was euthanized after an animal behaviorist determined the dog to be aggressive, Lt. Val Angeles said. Officials will decide by Wednesday whether to euthanize a boxer named Calliou or return the animal to its owners.
