

Dad saves 3-year-old son from vicious dog attack with bare hands in Bronx

A [Bronx](#) dad pummeled a 120-pound Husky with his bare hands to save his 3-year-old son from the vicious canine, police and witnesses said.

[Jeremiah Kendall](#), 32, peeled the dog away from his son, Kamrin, when a dimwit owner - who police identified as [Louis Delez](#), 23 - didn't try to stop the attack.

"He was closer to the dog than me," Kendall said. "I'm upset he didn't do anything."

Kendall was walking with his family outside of their [Hunts Point](#) home around 9 p.m. Thursday when, suddenly, the unleashed crazed canine attacked the tot.

"When I turned my back ... I heard him scream," Kendall said. "When I turned around, the white Husky was on [Kamrin]."

The hulking father kicked the hound off the young boy, then punched the dog in the face, he said.

"At the time I felt like Superman, because my son was in danger."

The hero dad could not save his child from injury, however.

"My son's face was full of blood," Kendall said. "I saw cuts on his eyes, face and nose."

Kamrin was transported to [Lincoln Hospital](#) with wounds to his face and head, police sources said.

Family members visited boy, who is in stable condition, at the hospital last night.

Delez was charged with reckless endangerment, cops said. The dog was sent to New York Animal Care and Control and put down, sources said.
