Humane Society Workers Cage "Grits"
After Attack

Omaha, NE - An American Bull Dog attacked a 12-year-old boy Tuesday night. Police say the boy went to the hospital with two bite wounds.

Neighbors near 47th and Crown Point tell Action 3 News the dog named Grits escaped from his chain and ran after a group of children. The kids scattered into a nearby house and onto cars. Witnesses says the dog tackled Thomas and bit him in his armpit.

The dog's owner, Kathy Marie Neal, says the kids provoked Grits. She says he is a kind dog that never has hurt anyone.

Nebraska Humane Society Vice-President Mark Langan says Grits will be quarantined for ten days to check for rabies. Langan says the dog is not licensed or vaccinated. Kenneth Neal was ticketed for several violations including harboring a dangerous animal.
