A TWO-YEAR-OLD girl has "severe facial injuries" after being bitten by a dog in Sydney.

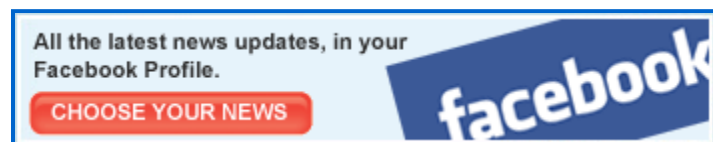
The toddler was bitten on her face by a half German Shepherd and husky dog at a house in Woodcroft, Blacktown, about 10.30am.
