

Surprise boy, 3, in hospital after being attacked by dog

A child in Surprise suffered serious injuries after being attacked by a dog Saturday night.

The 3-year-old boy was with his parents in their neighbor's backyard for a gathering when the neighbor's German shepherd mix attacked the boy without warning, Surprise police said.

The boy has severe facial injuries from the attack and he was transported by air to a hospital in [Phoenix](#), police said. The injuries do not appear to be life threatening.

Surprise Police Animal Care and Control officers quarantined the dog. Police are investigating the incident.
