## OWNER FACES CHARGES AFTER DOG BITES WOMAN

**New London** - A dog owner was issued several infractions Thursday morning, after his boxer dog bit a woman on Denison Avenue.

Police Capt. William Dittman said the call at 8:36 a.m. reported that a person had been bitten. The victim told police the dog ran up to her from Shaw Street, with a leash dragging from its collar, and bit her on the ankle and wrist. The dog then ran down Robinson Street.

An ambulance took the woman to Lawrence & Memorial Hospital where she was treated for lacerations on the ankle.

The dog's owner, Deborah Lewis, of 184 Shaw St., was issued infractions for having an unlicensed dog, a nuisance dog and a roaming dog. The dog, named Travis, is being held on a quarantine at the New London Animal Control Facility.
