Police seek info on Hamilton Street dog bite

MANITOWOC — The Manitowoc Police Department is looking for information on a small dog that bit a woman Tuesday evening on Hamilton Street.

The animal is described as a toy-size, white and brown, longhaired, “scruffy looking” dog. It is believed the dog had a collar, as the victim reported hearing a jingling noise as it approached her from behind. The woman told police she reached down and was bitten on the left hand, resulting in a puncture wound.

The incident occurred between 8 and 8:30 p.m. in the 2200 or 2300 block of Hamilton Street.
