**NEWS****Swan dies after Broads dog attack**

A warning for dog walkers to keep their pets under control in the countryside has come from a Norfolk animal rescue centre after a swan was savaged to death.

The adult mute swan died from "horrific" bite injuries to the neck and chest in the attack between Stokesey and Billockby in the Broads.

A team from the Seal and Bird Rescue Centre from Ridlington in north Norfolk went to the scene after people who witnessed the attack thought the bird might still be alive.

But trustee Daniel Goldsmith said the swan had "no chance of surviving."

Witnesses said the black Labrador-sized dog, which was with a party of people out walking, ran across the marshes towards three swans. Two escaped but the third was grabbed by the dog.

Mr Goldsmith said the incident was being reported to police, and it highlighted the need for people to keep their dogs under control in the countryside, especially when walking near wild and farm animals.
