A young child had to be airlifted to Pitt County Memorial Hospital Thursday night after [A](#) | [A](#) | [A](#) being bitten by a dog.

It happened after 7:00 p.m. in the 200 block of Thompson Street in Colerain, Bertie County.

First responders say the six or seven year-old boy was bitten by a German Shepard on his head.

Neighbors say the boy is from Ahoskie and was visiting grandparents.

The extent of the child's injuries are unknown, but they're not believed to be life-threatening.
