### FD: Dog bite tears scalp of 4-year-old Phoenix child

A 4-year-old boy is recovering after being bitten in the face by a dog on Friday.

According to Phoenix Fire Department spokesman Courtney Jenkins, somehow the pet of family friends staying at a nearby home was provoked

This happened at a home near 20th Street and Indian School Road around noon.

Skin on the boy's forehead was torn and his cheek was gouged, Jenkins said.

The child was transported to Phoenix Children's Hospital and is expected to be OK.

There is no word on what will happen to the dog.
