

Phoenix toddler bitten in face by Great Dane

A Phoenix toddler was taken to the [emergency room](#) after a Great Dane bit her on the face Tuesday morning.

The two-year-old girl was taken to St. Joseph's Hospital with non life-threatening head and facial injuries. Emergency crews responded to a dog bite call at a home near Central and Southern avenues about 10:49 a. m., said Shelly Jamison of the [Phoenix Fire Department](#).

"Whoever was on scene at the time was able to staunch the bleeding before crews arrived," Jamison said.

Officials are unsure why the Great Dane bit the child. [Animal Control](#) was called to the scene and the dog was isolated while the investigation continued.
