Conn. trooper sues after bite from police dog

BRIDGEPORT, Conn.

A Connecticut state trooper is suing Bridgeport and the city's police department after being bitten by a police dog.

Trooper Joseph Diaz says he suffered significant and permanent injuries on Jan. 14 when he was attacked by the police dog while on a routing traffic stop.

The lawsuit claims Bridgeport Police Officer Heriberto Rodriguez failed to control his police dog, Sampson.

The 26-year-old trooper suffered injuries to his left hand when he was attacked by the police dog when state and local officers stopped a vehicle on a city street.
