Police appeal for information after a man is bitten by a dog while walking in Pamber Woods

POLICE have appealed for information after a man was bitten by a dog in Pamber Woods. The 56-year-old victim recently told police that between 1pm and 5pm on Sunday, September 6, he was walking his dog in the woods, along a footpath heading towards Little London. The man stopped to speak to a woman who was walking her dog with a younger woman. As he went to pat the dog, it bit him on both hands. He received hospital treatment for the injuries. It is thought the dog was a black Alsatian. The woman walking the dog was around 5ft 10ins tall, with short, auburn hair and of fairly large build. Pc Mark Pullman, of Tadley police, said: "We are keen to trace the owner of the dog and would ask anyone who knows who it might belong to, to contact us as soon as possible. "The dog owner originally helped the victim and said she would return the next day but never did and we would appeal directly to her to come forward." Anyone with information about the incident should contact Pc Pullman at Tadley police station on 101 or call the Crimestoppers charity anonymously on 0800 555111.

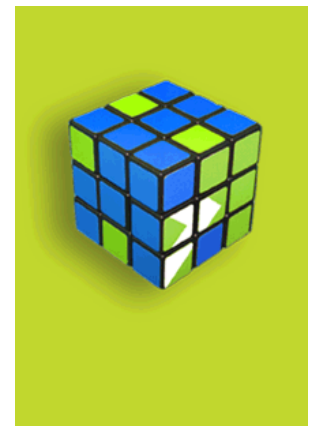
