Owner Fined For Chihuahua Shot To Death By Police

### ***Dog Killed After Biting Blue Ash Police Officer***

**BLUE ASH** -- The case of an attack on a police officer that ended with the shooting death of a small dog came to an end Monday – at least for now.

Court records state that Scottie Bullock's Chihuahua-mix, "Jack," bit Blue Ash officer Ken Johnson as the officer tried to capture the loose dog on June 9, 2009.

When the dog wouldn't let go of Johnson's right hand, another officer shocked it with a Taser, then shot the dog three times when the dog still wouldn't let go.

The police report states that the dog didn't release Johnson's hand until the third shot.

Bullock was out of town at the time and admitted he didn't know the dog was loose.

On Monday, Bullock was fined \$100 for violating the city's vicious dog ordinance. He had been found guilty in February of violating the ordinance.

Blue Ash police said in a report that Bullock's ex-wife told officers, "Officer Johnson deserved to have his hand chewed up."

Johnson filed a lawsuit against Bullock earlier this year, saying the dog caused "severe injury to his hands and arms, causing pain and suffering and scarring, which is permanent."

But this might not be the end of the trial over the vicious dog ticket.

The judge's note filed Monday indicates that the sentence is stayed pending appeal.
