Bryan authorities are investigating a dog bite incident that left a 12-year-old girl injured.

According to Bryan Police, the call came in shortly before 7 p.m. Thursday night. The caller requested an ambulance because a young girl had been bitten in the 1200 block of Web Hollow.

Lacey Emert witnessed the attack and told News 3 that the girl and her 5-year-old brother were riding bicycles and that neither child provoked the animal.

Emert says after the girl was knocked off of her bicycle, she heard her yell for help and that's when she went to their rescue and took them into her own home until police arrived.

The child was transported to St. Joseph Regional Health Center for treatment.

The dog's owner, Caleb Blakey also spoke with News 3 and said once he heard of the incident, he was immediately concerned for the girl.

Blakely also said his dog, Sam has never bitten or growled at anyone and has never been an aggressive dog.

The German Shepherd is under observation at the Brazos Animal Shelter, according to BPD officials. Authorities did issue Blakely a citation.
